Security and other improvements

Netop Remote Control version 12.83 for Windows focuses on security improvements for the Netop **Host**. This was achieved by preventing users to gain unwanted higher privileges by exploiting the fact that the Host runs with higher privileges.

For instance, one of the several security improvements done in this version is the fact that local logs are now saved by default in the Netop **Host** folder, instead of allowing the user to choose any path on the disk. The reason for this is that a malicious user might exploit the ability to access folders with privileged permissions.

In order to still allow for flexibility in choosing any path for saving Netop local logs, a custom path can still be defined using a new netop.ini setting, as described in the [Define a custom path for the Netop log file](#) article. Also, any custom path previously defined in the **Host** for the local logs will be automatically migrated on upgrade to this new setting in netop.ini, to keep the same behavior as before the update.
